Trucks must wait in the P15 area for instructions from circuit staff on parking assignment. One service truck per team (from 1 to 5 cars) will be allowed to park near the Challenge tents. Any other trucks/trailers must be parked in the overflow area.

Teams' trucks parked near the tents will not be allowed to leave the Paddock until 18:00 of Sunday, October 26th.

- No golf carts are allowed to park in the Paddock.
- Shuttle service connecting Paddock- Parking Areas Restaurant will be available during the event.
- The tent allocation will be published on the virtual board by October, 13th. The teams participating in the test days will stay in the same tent(s) until the end of the event.
- Club Challenge Teams: all teams not taking part in Finali Mondiali event must unload their equipment in the dedicated tent (Club Competizioni GT tent), and must reload it at the end of the activities on Tuesday at 18:30.
- Unauthorized cars in the paddock will be removed starting Saturday, October 18th

- · It is forbidden smoking and use of free flames;
- It is forbidden the storage of inflammable materials which must be placed in open air;
- Fire extinguishers and hydrants must be kept visible and working;
- · Access to escape doors and run off areas must be assured avoiding any obstruction;
- · Exhausted oils must be poured in the tanks placed in the paddock;
- In case of accidental pouring of inflammable liquids, oils or substances that can make the surfaces slippery, arrange for immediate removal and cleaning.
- The pit tent in the Paddock Challenge is a working area, each team is responsible for its assigned area. Only people involved in the event can access it.
